

Build An Ecosystem

Target Level 2nd, 3rd, and 4th graders

Students learn about the dependency between living and non-living components of a temperate forest ecosystem. They experience the basics of species interdependency within the ecosystem and its various habitats.

Format and Requirements:

A little set up ahead of time is required, and a flat surface like a table top or even the floor is needed so every student can observe the display. Binder includes setup instruction, background information and additional resources.

Standards of Learning:

- 2.5 The student will investigate and understand that living things are a part of a system. Key concepts include:
 - a) Interdependence of living and nonliving things
- 4.5 The student will investigate and understand how plants and animals, including humans, in an ecosystem interact with one another and with the nonliving components in the ecosystem.
 - b) Organization of populations, communities, and ecosystems and how they interrelate
